

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Missouri in General Assembly met,  
 That a committee of three members on the part of the Senate and five on the part of the House be appointed to take into consideration the subject of purchasing the necessary ground adjoining the State House property and erecting thereon a building for a Library and also a residence for the Governor and that they make report stating their views as to the propriety of the same and the probable expense thereof and that they accompany their report if favorable by a bill to carry the same report into effect.
