

Joint Resolution in relation to the State Library addition to  
the State House

Be it Resolved by the Senate and the House of  
Representatives of the State of Delaware in General Assembly met,

That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to pay to  
William J. Records, John Pyle, Henry A. McMullen and John W. Jolls each the  
sum of Two Hundred Dollars (200.) out of any moneys in the State Treasury  
not otherwise appropriated for services rendered in superintending  
the erection of the State Library addition to the State House.

also that a joint committee consisting of two on the part of the Senate  
and three on the part of the House be appointed to take into consider-  
ation the necessary changes to the interior of the State House to  
render it suitable for the various purposes for which it should be  
used, and that said committee report to the present General  
assembly the changes deemed necessary by them and the approximate  
cost thereof so that appropriate Legislation may be enacted to carry  
into effect such changes in the most expeditious and  
economical manner possible
