

Your Committee to whom was referred the Report of
the Auditor upon the Memorial of Joshua Gilpin,
begs leave to Report,

That they have examined
the said Report with the Papers accompanying it,
from which it appears, that George Evans, who was
duly appointed Commissioner of Stock, did sell the cattle
mentioned ~~therein~~ in the said Report, — that it appears
from the Minutes of the Vice-President and Council,
that "the Monies arising from such Sales were
Ordered to be retained until there be some legal
decision for the disposal thereof," — and that it does
not appear to your Committee that any such
Disposition was ever made. — Wherefore, your
Committee are of Opinion, that the sum of
Seventy eight Pounds, being the Valuation of
the Auditor for the Cattle, ought to be allowed
to Joshua Gilpin, the Memorialist, and that
an Order should issue on the Treasury for pay-
ment of the same.
