Henry Rudy of the Brandywine Paper Mills in Christiana  
hundred Newcastle County Delaware

Hath put, and by these presents doth put, place and bind his son John Rudy  
of the same Place, aged sixteen years on the 19th day  
of this present month December

Apprentice to Thomas Guerin of New  
Castle County, in the State of Delaware, manufacturer of Paper his  
Executors, Administrators or assigns  
to learn his Art, Trade and Mystery, and after the manner of an Apprentice, to serve him  
his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, from the day of the date hereof, for and during,  
and to the full end and Term of Five Years

next ensuing, during all which Term, the said Apprentice his said  
Master faithfully shall serve, his secrets keep, his lawful commands obey, and in all things  
behave himself as a good, and faithful Apprentice ought to do. And the said Master shall use  
the utmost of his endeavours, to teach, or cause the said Apprentice to be taught or instructed,  
in the Trade or Mystery of making and finishing paper as performed  
at the said Mills and shall well support and clothe, him during the said Appren-  
ticeship, and shall give him reasonable Education in Reading and Writing, and at the regular  
expiration of said Apprenticeship, furnish him with two suits of clothes, suitable to his condition,  
One whereof is to be new — To have four quarters  
of nights schooling or four months days schooling  
during the said apprenticeship

For the true performance of all and singular the Covenants and Agreements aforesaid, the  
said Parties bind themselves each unto the other, firmly by these Presents. In WITNESS
