From Coll Patterson. Condition &c. of ye Delaware Battaln
*This is written in lead pencil. 1777.

The Committee of Council appointed to take into Consideration a Report made to the General Assembly of this State by Messrs Collins & West ye 7 Jan'y Inst. of their proceedings as Commissioners to the Camp under the Command of His Excellency General Washington for the purposes in the Resolve of said Assembly of ye 5 November last, appointing said Commissioners—do now Report that, by the Return of said Commissioners it appears they did Commission Officers to serve in the Delaware Battalion to be raised in this State to serve during the present War on the Terms proposed by Congress; except a Lieutenant Colonel, & Major and also that since the filling up of said Commissions James Tilton who was then Commissioned as Surgeon to said Battalion hath resigned his said Commission; which appears by his letter inclosing the same to said Commissioners; Your Committee also report that the place of Colonel to said Battalion is now also become Vacant by the Death of John Haslet, Esqr.—It also appears to your Committee by the Return afd that an Error hath been committed in fixing the Rank of a Certain Peter Jacquet who in said Return is Commissioned as first second Lieutenant, and ought to be fifth first Lieutenant,

Your Committee are of Opinion that the several Vacant Offices afd ought to be filled up as soon as possible.—

It does not Appear that the said Commissioners have made any Return of the Condition of the Battalions commanded by Colonel Haslet Dec'd & Patterson as they was directed by the General Assembly—

Your Committee are of Opinion that the Account exhibited by said Commissioners of their Expences on the Business afd amounting to £38:1:9 be allowed and that the sum of Twenty four pounds be allowed by this State to said Thomas Collins & Sam'l West for their Service afd that is to say twelve pounds to each of them.—

Your Committee are in Doubt what mode would be best to rectify the afd-Error in the Rank of Peter Jacquet, & submit the same to the Determination of Council.

If this be the case, I expect, the Regiment will see the State, in triumph, yet before the close of the Winter—Our Army continues very sikly, but very little mortality—my officers are all almost poorly—The men are the heartiest in the Army, altho they do the severest Duty.

Inclosed I send your Excellency my last Monthly Return, by which you may see, we lose none

I hope this may continue, till I see the State, when I expect some notice will be taken of those brave fellows, who have lent their Aid in supporting the Character of the State.
