

This Indenture,

Made on Thursday, the Seventh day of October, in the year of our LOR D,
One thousand eight hundred and Nineteen being the Thursday next succeeding the day of the general election for the said year,
in and for New-Castle County, between John Moody Esquire, High Sheriff of the said County, of the one
part, and Henry Lodge, Peter Vandever, Robert Walker, John W. Kinley, Augustus M. Sehee,
Samuel Moore, Levi Clark, Leonard Pundgriff and Thomas Deahyne

Inspectors legally chosen and qualified to serve respectively at the general elections of a Governor of the State of
Delaware, a Senator and Seven Representatives for the County of New-Castle in the General Assembly
of the said State, and four Commissioners of the Levy Court & Court of Appeals for said County

which by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Delaware, were opened and commenced on the Fifth day of October,
being the first Tuesday in the said month; and George Peerce, Henry Colsbury, Richard Sexton and
John Thompson John Springer

Gentlemen free holders of said county, and electors present as aforesaid, for New-castle Hundred, and also at the calculation
and ascertainment of the aggregate amount of the whole number of Votes given for the respective candidates or persons voted
for at the said general election of the other part; Witnesseth, That the freemen and inhabitants of the County of New-castle
who voted at the said general elections, did meet for the purpose aforesaid according to the Constitution and Laws of the State
of Delaware, on Tuesday the Fifth day of October at the respective Places in the several Districts of the said County
appointed by Law; and that the said Inspectors in their respective Districts having been first duly qualified according to Law,
did then and there cause Proclamation to be made that the said election was then open; and further, that it appeared by the
respective returns duly certified and subscribed by the Judges respectively of the general elections holden as aforesaid, in the re-
spective election Districts of New-castle County, that Manain Bull had One thousand four hundred and forty
four Votes, Henry Molliston had Eight hundred and Ninety four Votes; H. Molliston had four Votes
George Ben had One Vote and Caleb A. Bennett had One Vote as Governor of the State of Delaware

and that the said John Moody Esquire, High Sheriff of said County of New-castle, after the casting up the
votes given for each candidate from the respective Districts in said county, on the said next Thursday succeeding the said general
election, at the Court-house in the Town of New-castle, did then and there forthwith Pronounce Publicly to the People there
assembled, the names so ~~listed~~ as aforesaid. IN WITNESS whereof as well the said Sheriff, as the said Inspectors and Free-
holders first before named, have to these Presents set their Hands and Seals respectively, the day and year first above written.
