## · CHAPTER 31

### STATE REVENUE TAYLOR'S BRIDGE, DISTRICT 66

AN ACT appropriating Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) for the erection of a new school building at Taylor's Bridge, District No. 66, in New Castle County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Delaware in General Assembly met:

\$5000 for new school building at Taylor's Bridge, N. C. Co.

Section 1. That the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) be and the same is hereby appropriated to be used in the erection and construction of a new school building at Taylor's Bridge, District 66 in New Castle County.

State Treasurer to pay upon warrant of State Board of Education

Section 2. The moneys hereby appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer from time to time as required by the State Board of Education, but such payments shall be made only upon order of the said State Board of Education, signed by its president or vice-president and its secretary.

General Fund

Section 3. This Act shall be known as a Supplementary Appropriation Act and the moneys hereby appropriated shall be paid out of the general fund of the State Treasury.

Approved April 17, A. D. 1923.
