

Section 11th And be it enacted that the said corporations shall not have, possess or in any manner hold, goods, chattels, rights, credits, lands, tenements or property, of any kind, the clear yearly income or revenue of which shall exceed three thousand dollars, and shall have in banking power, other than the lending of money on security for the purposes of permanent investment.

Section 12th And be it further enacted, that this act shall be deemed and taken to be a public act; and the power to make or alter this act is hereby reserved to the legislature.
