

An additional supplement to an Act entitled
"An Act for removing the seats of justice from
Lewes to a more central part of Sussex County
and for other purposes"

Whereas by the said Act to which this is
a supplement, Robert Houston, Robert
Shankland, George Mitchell, William
Moore and John Collins esquires, were
appointed commissioners to sell and
execute deeds for the conveyance of the
lots in Georgetown three of which
commissioners are since dead without
executing conveyances for many of the lots
sold by them and no provision being
made for the reappointment of com-
missioners in case of death, resignation, re-
moval or inability to serve in said capacity
Sect. 1. Be it therefore enacted by the Senate and
House of Representatives of the State of Dela-
ware in General Assembly met, That
Benton Hanes Doctor, James Robertson
and William Russell be and are hereby
nominated and appointed ^{to} commissioners

men in the place and stead of Robert Houston William Moore and George Mitchell esquires deceased and the said commissioners hereby nominated and appointed in lieu as aforesaid shall be vested with all the power and authority given to the commissioners in the Act to which this is a supplement and that the said surviving commissioners and the commissioners hereby nominated and appointed their successors and successors or a majority of them are hereby authorized required and empowered to sell all the lots in the Town aforesaid which remain unsold by the commissioners appointed as aforesaid and to execute deeds for the conveyance of all those lots that have heretofore been sold by the commissioners appointed by the Act to which this is a supplement.

Section 2. Be it further enacted That when vacancies shall hereafter happen by the death resignation removal or inability to serve of any of the said commissioners that

it shall and may be lawful for the City Court for the county of Suffolk to nominate and appoint a suitable person or persons to serve as commissioners for the purposes aforesaid.

Section 3. Be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that the following alleys and lanes in York Town to wit South Alley from Market Street to Council Street South Lane from Market Street to Council Street Cooper's Alley from Front Street as far as the town land extends Cherry Lane from Market Street to Cooper's Alley Cooper's Alley from lot number one to the south side of lot number two hundred and thirty three and two hundred and thirty six Strawberry Alley from Bedford Street with one hundred and twenty feet to the line that divides lot number forty one and forty four on the one side and are hereby held to be stopped up and done away and that the said alleys and lanes stopped up and done away as aforesaid shall be divided equally between the adjoining lot and land holders.
