

I have received this State, Quota of the copies of the acts of the second session of the sixteenth Congress of the United States. I have directed nine of these to be delivered to the Senate and twenty one to the House of Representatives and the residue to be disposed of according to law. I have also received copies of the Journal, of the Senate and of the House of Representatives, of the second session of the sixteenth Congress, and of the State papers of that session, of each of which I have directed one to be delivered to the Senate and one to the House of Representatives, the residue remain in the Secretary's office to be disposed of as the General Assembly may direct. I have received three copies of the revised Code of the Laws of New Jersey; one of these I have directed to be delivered to the Senate and one to the House of Representatives and one remains in the Secretary's office. I have also received three copies of the acts of the forty fifth General Assembly of New Jersey, which I have directed to be disposed of in like manner. I have received three copies of the Acts of the first session of the twenty ninth General Assembly of Kentucky; three copies of the Acts of the first session of the nineteenth General Assembly of Ohio; three copies of the Laws passed by the second General Assembly of Illinois; three copies of the first and second sessions of the thirteenth General Assembly of

Tennessee, three copies of Acts of the General Assembly
of Pennsylvania; three copies of Acts passed by the
Legislature of Vermont, three copies of Laws of Massa-
chusetts passed at the January & May sessions 1821;
and three copies of the Laws of New Hampshire passed
at the June session 1821; all which I have directed
to be disposed of in like manner. I have also received
two copies of the Acts of the first session of the fifth Legi-
slature of ~~Missouri~~ Louisiana; and two copies of Acts
and Resolutions of the General Assembly of the State of
South Carolina passed in December 1820 - of these
I have directed one copy to be retained in the Office
of the Secretary of State & the other to be delivered to
the Senate. I have also received one copy of the Laws
of the State of Indiana, which I have directed to
be retained in the ~~same~~ office of the Secretary
of State - and also one copy of the Report of J. Q. Adams
