and Isaac J. Hearn William S. White M. E. Britt-  
ingham Benjamin H. Downs Joseph Lewis  
Elijah Hudson and W. Clay Mathews of the  
second part as Trustees of Whitesville Methodist  
Episcopal Parsonage in trust for the uses and  
purposes hereinafter mentioned Witnesseth that  
the said Jesse J. Wells and Louisa Wells  
his wife for and in consideration of the  
sum of twenty five dollars lawful money  
of the United States to them in hand paid  
by the said Trustees as aforesaid before  
the delivery of these presents the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained  
sold alieneed enfeoffed released conveyed and  
confirmed and by their presents do grant  
bargain sell enfeoff release convey and  
confirm unto the said parties of the second  
part Trustees as aforesaid and their suc-  
cessors as provided for by the laws of the  
State of Delaware and the discipline of the  
Methodist Episcopal Church of the United States  
of America in trust for the uses and pur-  
poses hereinafter mentioned all that certain  
piece or lot of Ground situate in Canton  
Hundred Sussex County and State of Delaware

Southwest where the new County road intersects the old county road leading from Whitesboro to Amanda Means then running east forty feet to a corner thence north one hundred and thirty two feet to a corner thence west fifty feet to the County road thence South along the line of said road one hundred and forty three feet to the place of beginning, Together with all and singular the buildings improvements fixtures ways woods waters rights liberties privileges and appurtenances whatsoever thenceforth belonging and also all the right title interest estate claim and demand whatsoever of the said Jesse T. Mills and Louisa Mills his wife in law or in equity in to of or out of the same and every part thereof to have and to hold the lands and premises hereby bargained and sold unto the said Isaac Hearn William J. White M. C. Smith Brigham Benj. M. Corson Joseph Lewis Elijah Hudson and H. Clay Matthews Trustees and their successors as aforesaid forever in trust nevertheless and for the purposes following to wit: that the said Trustees and their successors as aforesaid shall hold the said premises in trust that the said premises shall be used kept maintained and held as a place of residence for the use and occupancy of the Preachers of the Methodist Episcopal Church in the United States of America who may from time to time be stationed in said place subject to the usage and discipline of said Church as from time to time authorized and declared by the General Conference of said Church and by the annual Conference within whose bounds said premises are situated. And the said Jesse T. Mills and Louisa Mills his wife their heirs executors and administrators do hereby further grant covenant and agree to and with the said Trustees and their successors as aforesaid that the lands and premises hereby bargained and sold with all the appurtenances thenceforth belonging against them the said Jesse T. Mills and Louisa Mills his wife their heirs assigns and administrators and against all persons claiming or lawfully to claim the same or any part or parcel thereof by through or under them or any of them unto the said Trustees and their successors as aforesaid that the said Jesse T.
