
WON'T ALLOW THE ROAD TO CROSS.

The Delaware Railroad Company has ordered the Queen Anne Railroad Company to discontinue the construction of a signal tower, signals and other appurtenances where the former track is crossed at Greenwood, this state. The Queen Anne railroad has been completed to Greenwood for some time, and much work done east of the Delaware railroad track towards Lewes but the Delaware railroad tracks have never been crossed by the Queen Anne railroad. Preparations have been in progress for some time, and plans and specifications have been submitted to the Delaware Railroad Company for its approval. Work was begun this week at the intersection of the tracks. The foundation for the signal tower was begun, and the erection of a signal, when orders were received from the Delaware Railroad Company to discontinue the work.
