

SUPREME COURT IN SESSION

Argument Begun in Case of Queen Anne Railroad vs. Mary E. Reed.

In Dover yesterday the June term of the Delaware Supreme Court was opened. Chancellor Nicholson is presiding, and Justices Pennewill, Boyce, Spruance and Grubb are on the bench.

Argument was begun in the case of the Queen Anne Railroad Company versus Mary E. Reed, plaintiff below. Mrs. Reed's husband, John W. Reed, was killed on the tracks of the railroad company, near Milton, about two years ago, and her suit for damages was awarded in the lower court.

The case of the Star Publishing Company, plaintiff in error, versus John P. Donahoe, defendant, was continued until July 9, when it will be especially taken up by the counsel.
