

## WILL BE COMPLETED SOON.

THE QUEEN ANNE RAILROAD EXPECTED TO BE IN OPERATION BY CHRISTMAS.

It is expected that the new Queen Anne railroad will be ready for traffic by Christmas. President Bosley said yesterday that the line from Queens-town, Md., to Greenwood, Del., thirty-five miles, is completed, with the exception of three miles. The draw in the bridge over the Choptank river will be in position on December 1.

The telegraph line between Queens-town and Greenwood is finished, as are also several of the stations, both passenger and freight. Work on the unfinished stations is being pushed with all possible haste. The pier at Queens-town is up. It is the largest on the Chesapeake bay, and has a capacity for three trains. The rolling stock has been purchased and some of it has been delivered, including several engines.

The passenger and freight cars, which were built by the Jackson and Sharp Company, of Wilmington, are now stored in the builders' warehouse and will be shipped when wanted.
