

The Court held at the County of Sussex on the 15th day of May 1706

Proger Corbett appeared in Open Court and acknowledged and made over to the publick, for a Religious place of worship or Church, one Acre of Land situate on the South side of Low Branch in Angles Neck on the

County of Sussex, To have and to Hold, the same for the use aforesaid with Warrantes from him his heirs and Assigns forever, by deed of Gift in Open Court acknowledged and delivered bearing date the eighth day of this Instant May 1706

Samuel Knowles and Jane his wife Adminrs of the good and Lawfull Right and Credits of Thomas Ascent Taylor deceased appeared in Open Court and acknowledged and made Over unto Edward Stretcher, One four Acre Lot of Land in the Town of Lewes, on the South side of Mullbury Street between the said Edward Stretcher Lots, of Justice Phillip Nupel, To have and to Hold, the same unto the said Edward Stretcher his heirs and Assigns forever according to the Contents of a Conveyance in Open Court, by the said Sam: and Jane to the said Edward delivered, bearing date the 6th day of this Instant May 1706

Proger Corbett appeared in Open Court and acknowledged and made Over unto Woodman Stockley and William Atkins, Three Hundred Acres of Land situate on the South side of Low Creek and Branch in Angles Neck, within this County of Sussex, To have and to Hold, the same, unto the said Woodman Stockley and William Atkins jointly and severally, their heirs and Assigns forever according to the Contents of a Conveyance by the said Proger in Open Court to the said Woodman and William delivered, bearing date the seven th day of this Instant May 1706

Act Vanhish appeared in Open Court and acknowledged and made Over to Thomas Kemmons 200 Acres of Land, by Conveyance, bearing date the 5th day of June 1704
