Bennett and Lucy P. his wife in the State of Delaware of the one part and James Bennett of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that they the said Charles D. Bennett and Lucy P. his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars lawful money of the State of Delaware aforesaid to them in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the aforesaid James Bennett the receipt whereof they the aforesaid doth hereby acknowledge and from every part and parcel thereof do hereby acquit, release and discharge herein the said James Bennett his heirs and assigns forever. Have granted bargained & sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto him the said James Bennett his heirs and assigns forever part of a tract of land Called Spring field, Beginning in the fork of a road that leads from Iron Hills Exp. the one prong leading to lotus said Charles D. Bennett now resides, and the other prong leading to where Warren Jeffers formerly lived also at or near the end of the eighth line of a Deed Warren Jeffers to Thomas Evans thence running along and with a road commonly Called Jefferss Road North Twenty two degrees East fourteen poles. Thence along and with road to the division line between said Bennett and the Mallets thence with said line to an old road commonly called the hind road thence along and with the same reversing the several Courses and distances
