Copy of the Minutes of St George's Church.

at George's Church, Dublin, this being the day of
 Easter Monday, March 29th 1864. After being the day of
 present by law for the annual Election of Wards, Man
 a number of the qualified voters of the congregation at
 present at St George's Church, at ten o'clock, P.M. on
 Monday, Thomas M. Butler was chosen Chairman of the
 Meeting, and James G. Butler was appointed Clerk.
 On Motion of John B. Butler, it was ordered that
 we now proceed to the Election of seven Wardsmen for
 the parish for the ensuing Year, Messrs John B.
 Butler, and Augustus J. Butler were appointed to receive and
 count the ballots of all the qualified voters present. Then
 Thomas M. Butler, John B. Butler, John W. Butler, James
 G. Butler, James G. Butler, William G. Butler and
 William G. Butler were each named a majority of the
 votes cast, and resolved to be elected Wardsmen of St
 George's Church, for the ensuing Year. On Motion resolved
 that the said Wardsmen and Chairman be called for the
 Maintenance of Regular Service in St George's Chapel, and
 the Chapel of the Cemetery for one Year from this date.
 and that the Wards be instructed to take up subscriptions
 for that purpose. The Meeting then adjourned to Tuesday
 the 30th of March 1864. The Wards elected being
 called together by the Clerk, the Roll was called, and the
 following Wardsmen answered to their Names, to wit, Augustus
 G. Butler, John B. Butler, and James G. Butler. There not
 being a Quorum, on Motion the Wards adjourned to meet on
 Wednesday, the 31st of March next 1864.
 At George's Church, Dublin, on the 31st of March
 Church having met according to adjournment, the Roll was
 called, and the following Wardsmen answered to their Names
 to wit, John B. Butler, Thomas M. Butler, William G. Butler
 and James G. Butler, on Motion it was ordered that the
