Administration and Collection of Inheritance Tax

"The administration and enforcement of the provisions of this act and the collection of the taxes, interest and penalties imposed by this act are hereby vested in the State Tax Department and the State Tax Commissioner as created and defined in Chapter 8 of Volume 36, Laws of Delaware."

General Instructions

Every executor or administrator shall within three months after the granting of letters testamentary or administration, file in the office of Register of Wills of the County in which said letters have been granted, and also with the State Tax Commissioner, an inventory of all goods and chattels, a list of all debts and credits and a statement in writing setting forth a general description of every parcel of real estate in this State of which the decedent died seized and the name of each party entitled to any estate or interest in any parcel of said real estate and relationship, if any, of said party to the decedent. Such inventory list and statement shall be supported by oath or affirmation of said executor or administrator. Any executor or administrator who fails to file within the prescribed period shall be subject personally and individually, to a penalty of \$1.00 per day for each day delinquent.

If decedent owned no property of the kind described in any of the following schedules, the word "None" should be written on the page.

A schedule of deductions (Form 30) must be filed with the State Tax Department within thirteen months after the date of death.

No commission shall be allowed by the Register of Wills to any executor or administrator who has not complied with the requirements of the Inheritance Tax Law.
