THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE WRITTEN OBLIGATION IS SUCH,

That if *Robert H. Cary* aforesaid, and *Susan J. Davis* may lawfully unite themselves in marriage, and if there be no legal objection to celebrating the rights of marriage between them, then the said obligation shall be void, otherwise to be and remain in force.
