This Governor's Day we honor the memory of statesman Joseph
Maul Carey, who was born in Milton and served as the Governor
of Wyoming and also as one of the state's first U.S. Senators. Two
historical markers are being unveiled on this Governor's Day 2006
– one honoring Governor Carey and one depicting the oldest
surviving commercial building in Milton – the Carey Storehouse,
which is listed in the National Register of Historic Places and a
prominent part of the Milton Historic District.
