GENERAL INFORMATION

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: High school graduate or equivalent or 18 years of age.

TUITION: \$350 per year for full time students.
Scholarships, work-study programs will be available.

TERMS: The college will operate on a quarter system except the College Transfer Division which will operate on semesters. Most occupational courses will run on a three semesters per year basis, but some will continue for four semesters.

NIGHT CLASSES: Evening classes will include all courses of study offered in the day program on an extended basis, except college transfer credits.

DEVELOPMENTAL LABORATORY: A Developmental Laboratory will be available for remedial work to improve deficiencies in the subject areas and reading skills.

GENERAL STUDIES — 1 year — Certificate of Completion

The Division of General Studies allows students not fully prepared to enter the Occupational/Technical Curriculum or the College Transfer Section to enroll in a one year course of study. Extensive time is offered in the Developmental Laboratory to improve reading skills and make up any deficiencies in subject areas. Ample opportunity will be provided to take courses in the other divisions for orientation purposes.
