REGISTRATION

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

High School graduates or adults, eighteen years of age or over.

FEES

\$5 per credit hour for Delaware residents; \$10 per credit hour for non-residents. Fees are due and payable in full at registration; no partial payments will be accepted. Fees for special courses are based on the number of class meetings per quarter.

WITHDRAWALS

Special Course Descriptions

Delaware Technical and Community College, Southern Branch, through its Evening Division will offer in the Winter Quarter beginning December 5, the following non-credit courses for everyone in the community, including employees in business and industry who wish to up-grade their skills.

FEDERAL INCOME TAX — An introductory course in Federal Income Tax for those who wish to file their own returns. Topics include personal exemptions, proper reporting of salary and income, business or farm income, deductions, reporting dividends and interest, annuities, and others. Emphasis will be in how to file individual returns.

8 weekly sessions beginning Tuesday, December 10; Time: 7:00-9:30 P.M. Fee: \$10

SMALL BUSINESS MANAGEMENT SEMINAR — A series of eight (8) lectures and discussions on managing a small business led by various authorities in sales, legal requirements, credit and financing, record keeping, taxes, insurance, as well as other topics.

In cooperation with the Small Business Administration of the U.S. Government.

8 weekly sessions beginning Monday, January 13; Time: 7:00-9:30 P.M. Fee: \$10

ADVANCED BLUE PRINT READING — BUILDING TRADES — An advanced course in interpreting architectural blueprints as used in residential building trades; covers architectural symbols, floor plans, elevations, sections, and various detail drawings.

12 weekly sessions beginning Monday, December 9; Time: 6:30-9:00 P.M. Fee: \$15

ADVANCED BLUE PRINT READING — MACHINE TRADES — An advanced course in the study and interpretation of blueprints as used in typical industrial plants; fundamental principles of representing objects by blueprints.

12 weekly sessions beginning Monday, December 9; Time: 6:30-9:00 P.M.

Fee: \$15

COMMERCIAL ART — Basic course including layout, lettering (brush, pen, pencil, etc.), color and design, basic drawing, posters (layout to silk screen prints and film cutting), techniques, photography, and newspaper and magazine ads.

12 weekly sessions beginning Tuesday, December 10; Time: 6:30-9:30 P.M. Fee: \$18

EFFECTIVE SPEAKING — Course designed to develop selfconfidence and provide opportunities for self-expression including basic principles of speech, parliamentary procedure, and emphasis on group dynamics.

12 weekly sessions beginning Wednesday, December 11; Time: 6:30-8:30 P.M. Fee: \$12

BASIC PHOTOGRAPHY — Basic course which will include basic camera, modern variations of the camera, various black and white films and their application, light, lenses, exposure, elementary compositions, introduction to darkroom technique, reversal color, negative color, and introduction to home movies.

12 weekly sessions beginning Thursday, December 12; Time: 6:30-8:30 P.M. Fee: \$12

READING FOR EXECUTIVES — Course designed for graduates, business and industrial personnel who wish to increase reading rate, improve comprehension. Course limited to fifteen (15) persons.

10 weekly sessions beginning Tuesday, December 10; Time: 6:30-8:30 P.M. Fee: \$10

SLIDE RULE — Principles and operation of the slide rule, with practical application in the use of basic scales for multiplication, division, roots and powers, ratio and proportions, and combined operations as well as instruction on scales, including trigonometric and logarithmic functions.

10 weekly sessions beginning Monday, December 9; Time: 8:30-10:30 P.M. Fee: \$10
