

Return Day

*Excerpts from a newspaper article from
1878 reporting on "Return Day"*

"A time-honored custom"

On the Thursday following every state election this gathering, which has nothing exactly like it in any other state or spot in the Union, is the event on which the eye of every Delawarean with political inclinations is focused. Away back in the time when Delawareans first began to exercise the right of franchise as one of the original thirteen States, all of Sussex County came to Georgetown to vote.

The polls were opened in the courthouse early on Monday and remained open until Wednesday night. The voters came from the "hundreds" or townships round about, in ox carts, on horseback, or on foot and brought their rations with them.

After they had voted they camped on the public square. On Thursday the vote was counted and the returns posted in front of the courthouse. Painters were busy marking on canvass the result of the election in other states, which were stretched like huge banners of victory from court house windows and hotel porches. Fleet horsemen brought the figures from the rest of the State and such other parts of the country as could be reached in time and they were read as received from the steps of the court house to the assembled population of Sussex.

"Return Day in Sussex" has become as celebrated as the Fourth of July or any other great national holiday. There is nervous bustle all over the town, the hostelrys are provisioned with lavishness, the boys are getting their Sunday breeches prepared, and the girls prepare their best gowns and most stunning hats for the display.

On the whole Return Day is an orderly and enjoyable political festival which age cannot wither nor custom stale.



Quote from the Easton Md. Gazette November 8th 1878

John M. Clayton, Delaware U.S. Senator and U.S. Secretary of State in President Taylor's administration once said of Return Day "that the man who had been to a political meeting in Dagsboro, seen Return Day in Georgetown and visited Paris had witnessed the three most interesting sights in the world!"

It is just possible that Paris may furnish more splendid opportunities for the satisfaction of the aesthetic tastes, but I doubt if anywhere else there can be found such an opportunity for observing curious types of a peculiar people as at the Sussex County seat on election Return Day. The congregation of people from all parts of the county on such occasions is probably a relict of the English customs, where the supporters and constituents of the Parliamentary candidates assemble at the county seat to learn the result of the contest. It was, and is, I believe the custom of these times for the member elect to entertain the people with feasts and music.
