

*A supplement to the act entitled "An act
for the benefit of Sussex County."*

*"Whereas by an act entitled "An Act to authorize
"the building of a Court-House and fire-proof Offices
"at Georgetown, in Sussex County"; the State Treas-
urer was directed to pay to the commissioners ap-
pointed by the said act, the sum of five thousand
dollars out of the surplus fund of this State, upon
the order of the Levy Court of Sussex County, to be
applied in the erection of said Court-House and
fire-proof offices; which said sum has been received
and so applied: And whereas by the original
act to which this is a supplement, the sum of ten
thousand dollars to be raised by a lottery thereby
authorized, is to be applied by the trustees therein
appointed, for the erection of said Court-House:*
*Section 1. Therefore be it enacted by the Senate and
House of Representatives of the State of Dela-
ware, in General Assembly met, that it shall
and may be lawful for the trustees appoin-
ted under the original act to which this is a
supplement, and they are hereby required to
apply five thousand dollars (so soon as the
same shall be received) out of the ten thous-
and dollars to be raised by lottery as aforesaid,
to the repayment of the said five thousand
dollars of the surplus fund: And after the com-
pletion of the said Court-House, fire-proof offi-
ces, and discharging such incidental expenses
as may be incurred in relation to said buildings
and the enclosure thereof, and after a fair and
reasonable allowance to the said trustees, to be
made as is provided in the seventh section of
the act to which this is a supplement; if any*

part of the said sum of ten thousand dollars shall remain unexpended, the same shall be paid over by the said trustees to the commissioners appointed by an act, entitled "An Act to erect and keep in good repair a bridge over Broad-helm Creek, where the State Road crosses the said creek at a place called Samuel Paynter's Landing," to be used and applied in the construction and completion of the bridge authorized by the last said act: But the sum so to be paid over by the said trustees to the said commissioners, shall not exceed two thousand five hundred dollars; or if a less sum will be sufficient to construct and complete said bridge, then only so much of said sum of twenty five hundred dollars as shall be necessary for said purpose, shall be paid over, used or applied therefor.

Section 2. And be it enacted, that in case the sum of fifteen thousand dollars authorized by the first section of the original act, to which this is a supplement, to be raised by the lottery therein mentioned, shall be hereafter received by the said trustees, the same, instead of being applied to the improvement of the navigation of Broad Creek, as directed in the said first section of the original act to which this is a supplement, shall be paid or applied to the use and benefit of Sussex County, under the order and direction of the Levy Court of said County, to be applied to such objects and purposes, as the said Levy Court shall deem most beneficial to the citizens of the said County.
