

Frankford for two years was very much hindered by crop-fail ures and depression, and despite all possible struggle and effort there was some falling off in the benevolent collections - notwithstaming the hard times the church received some necessary repairs including a new roof which was elevated at the peak six feet higher than the old painting of the exterior of church refitting of seats and etc.

Juring the two years the parsonage dect was reduced from the neighborhood of 550 to 282 as it stood on Jan 7, 1891 and during 1890 an accumilation of old debts on the hourch amounting to \$256 was paid in full.

Among these old debts was sexton's unpaid salary bill for wome \$80. which had been standing some three or four years.

In fall of 1888 a revival of considerable interest took place at Rouston resulting in 180me 27 conversions, t a camp meeting held at laurel's Woods in 1890 27 conversions took place. In fall and winter of 1890 a great revival took place at St. George's sixty three professed conversions. Rearly all were adults. Took regations were sometimes larger than church would contain. Bearly all of these joined the church. Considerable spiritual interest prevailed in Frankford early in 1891 in the church but eight only professed conversions. conversions.

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

A history, in brief, of the nearly 900 churches and former churches in Delaware as located by the Author.

Lawsonia A. M. E. Zion Church was located in Piney Neck. The church site was donated, on Feb. 10, 1896, by Thomas B. Riggin. It has since become defunct.

Antioch A. M. E. Church is located one-half mile north of Frankford. It was established in 1856 when the old church of the Antioch Methodist, white congregation, was purchased and occupied. They took title to the property on Aug. 4, 1857, upon payment of \$70.00. On Feb. 28, 1890, one acre of land, forming the present church site, was purchased from Millard F. Murray and a new church was built. The old church was sold and moved to a site on the Highway below Frankford where it is now used as a dwelling. There is a large campmeeting ground beside the church where enthusiastic annual meetings are held. Electric lighting has replaced the old fire-stands. On Sun. morning, Aug. 15, 1943, fire of undetermined origin broke out in one of the cottages. Whipped by a high wind, the fire spread to other cottages and to the church. In spite of the efforts of six fire companies, the church and ten cottages were completely destroyed.

A new building was erected and was occupied in the early summer of 1946. The corner-stone was laid on July 26, 1946 by the Rev. G. M. Purnell,

the pastor. The church was dedicated in the fall of 1946.

Frankford Presbyterian Church was organized in 1875, when meetings were held in the schoolhouse. Land on Reed St. was purchased on Mar. 18, 1880, from John T. Reed. The church was built in 1880. It was arranged to hold the dedication services on Oct. 30, 1881. The church was incorporated on Sept. 11, 1894. Land on Thatcher St. was purchased on Mar. 23, 1904, from Mary A. Long.

Frankford Methodist Church (M.E.) was originally located in a woods about one-quarter mile n. e. of the John M. Clayton School on land now owned

by Everett Long.

This site was purchased on Apr. 10, 1819, from Joshua Robinson at a cost of \$14.37½. The trustees were Arthur Williams, David Hazzard, Stephen Ellis, John Hazzard and Percy Pool. The lot measured 78 sq. poles and was part of a large tract known as "Security." The trustees agreed to erect an M. E. church immediately which they did. This church was known as "Old Zion" and as "Antioch." The church was incorporated as "Antioch" on Mar. 4, 1820. The road upon which the church faced took the name of Antioch Road.

when it was decided to build a new church in Frankford, the old church property was sold to a negro congregation who took the name "Antioch

A. M. E. Church."

The church site, in Frankford, was purchased on Nov. 20, 1852, from Jonathan Carey. The corner-stone of the new church was laid on Aug. 28, 1853. When the new church was completed, it was named the "Frankford M. E. Church." In 1880, extensive repairs were made and the spire was added. Additional land was purchased on June 27, 1881, from Jos. S.. Carey. Repairs were made in 1901, and, in 1916, an ell containing a Sunday School room was added. There is a graveyard beside the church. The earliest legible tombstone inscription is dated 1868.

The Church of God at Frankford was organized in May, 1940 and they meet in Odd Fellows' Hall.

Grace P. E. Chapel, at Baltimore Mills, was located three-quarters of a mile north of Omar close to Lamb's Woods. This chapel was built to take the



Frankford United Methodist Church

In 1819, a group of Methodists purchased a parcel of land north of present-day Frankford. A frame chapel was erected, and on March 4, 1820, the members of the congregation met there to elect trustees and formally organize themselves as Antioch Methodist Episcopal Church. The members purchased the present site on November 20, 1852. The sanctuary was dedicated on August 28, 1853. The church was later renamed Frankford Methodist Episcopal Church.

In 1880, a new spire was added, and in 1889, the roof was elevated six feet. Leaded stained glass windows were added during this period. They are considered to be fine examples of the American Opalescent style of the late 19th century. An addition was constructed in 1916 and subsequently expanded with the completion of a second story in 1947. A fellowship hall was built in 1967.

Dear Russ:

Persistence! Finally, I have been able to track down some information on the church's leaded stained glass windows! Hopefully, some of this information will be relevant for the historical marker?

The windows were restored by the Willet Stained Glass Studios, 10 East Moreland Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19118 [215/247-5721] in 1996. Based on their examination, all but one of the windows is circa 1870. The only window that does not date back to that period is circa 1940.

According to Willet, "The windows of the Frankford United Methodist Church are traditional leaded stained glass windows. They were fabricated using mostly American Cathedral glasses (which is a transparent colored glass with a mechanical finish imparted by a roller) and some American opalescent glasses (which is an opaque, multicolored glass). The only painted glasses are the memorial plates and some painted symbol medallions, as well as the figure section of one window. The painting on the glasses was executed in both the traditional Trace and Matte Technique and the Enamel based technique of glasspainting.

"Most of the windows (except for the ladies Aid Society window and the window above the main entrance) are designed in the style of the American Opalescent School. It is a period design style that was popular about 100 years ago at the turn of the last century. The glass that was utilized is almost all of American origin; consequently, I am quite sure that the windows were designed and fabricated by an American stained glass studio. I did not find any signatures or identifying marks so I am unable to tell you which studio."

Willet Studios went on to describe American Opalescent Glass: "Some of the glass that is used in your windows is called American Opalescent Glass, which was invented in the mid 1800's by an American glass artist named John LaFarge. It became popular when Louis Comfort Tiffany of the famed Tiffany Studios of New York began using it extensively in his window and lamp creations. During the great church building period around the turn of the century, over 50% of the windows then being installed in churches were made with opalescent glass. One of the outstanding features of the opalescent glass is that it is opaque and both reflects and transmits light. This means that, unlike other types of stained glass, color in the glass is visible from the exterior during the day."

If I can be of any further assistance, please feel free to contact me. The Reverend Dr. Reed Stewart and I are anxiously awaiting a copy of your proposed draft of the plaque's wording.

Enclosed are four (4) historical sketches of the Frankford United Methodist Church, which I have been able to locate. The sketch from Frank R. Zebley's book, <u>The Churches of Delaware</u>, seems to be very complete. I suspect that you have a copy of this book?

Regarding the overall approach to this marker, I would like to recommend that it reflect the complete history of the Frankford United Methodist Church, not just the history of the current structure. I doubt if many of the church's current members even realize the long, rich history that this church has shared with the evolution of Frankford!

There is one element of the church's history on which I have not been able to locate any factual data and that is on the origin of the stained glass windows. They are some of the most intricately designed windows in the area; yet their history remains a mystery. If you know how I might be able to research this matter further, please let me know. I think it would be wonderful if they could mentioned on the plaque with some historical facts as reference.

THE CHURCHES OF DELAWARE

By

Frank R. Zebley

Frankford United Methodist Church (M.E.) was originally located in a woods about one-quarter mile northeast of the John M. Clayton School on land owned by Everett Long.

This site was purchased on April 10, 1819, from Joshua Robinson at a cost of \$14.371/2. The Trustees were Arthur Williams, David Hazzard, Stephen Ellis, John Hazzard, and Percy Pool. The lot measured 78 sq. poles and was part of a large tract known as "Security." The Trustees agreed to erect a M.E. church immediately, which they did. This church was known as "Antioch" and "Old Zion". The church was incorporated as "Antioch" on March 4, 1820. The road which the church faced took the name of Antioch Road.

When it was dedicated to build a new church in Frankford, the old church property was sold to a Black congregation who took the name "Antioch A.M.E. Church."

The church site in Frankford was purchased on November 20, 1852, from Jonathan Carey. The corner stone of the new church as laid on August 28, 1953. When the new church was completed, it was named the "Frankford A. E. Church". In 1880, extensive repairs were made and the spire was added. Additional land was purchased on June 27, 1881 from Joseph S. Carey. Repairs were made in 1901 and, in 1916, an ell containing a Sunday School Room was added. There is a graveyard beside the church. The earliest legible tombstone inscription is dated 1868.

A HISTORICAL SKETCH OF FRANKFORD UNITED METHODIST CHURCH

Frankford Methodist Church was originally located in a woods about ½ mile northeast of Indian River School, midway between Frankford and Dagsboro. The site was purchased on April 10, 1819, from Joshua Robinson at a cost of \$14.371/2. The Church as then known as "Antioch."

The present site was purchased and the Frankford M.E. Church was organized on November 20, 1952. The congregation moved into the new church in the fall of 1853.

The Church was renovated in 1874. In 1880, a new spire was added to the Church and in 1889, the roof was elevated six feet and a new roof put on.

The present church parsonage was built in 1882.

In 1916, a need arose for more room and the "Ell" was constructed for a Sunday School room. In 1947, a second floor was made in this "Ell". In 1952, a central hot water heating system was installed and an electric organ was purchased.

In 1955, the parsonage was completely renovated with central hot water heating system installed.

In 1967, we desperately needed more Sunday School room and a new building was constructed adjacent to the Sanctuary. This was named the "Bennett Building" in honor of the Reverend Elmer E. Bennett, who was Pastor at the time and also instrumental in getting the building erected.

By 1973, the Sanctuary was showing its "wear and tear." Complete renovations were begun in the summer and completed in 1974 under the leadership of Reverend Curtis W. Smith. Electric heat replaced the old hot water system and a new Conn Organ was purchased. Worship services resumed in the New Sanctuary in November, 1974.

It is interesting to note the changes of pastors from 1852 to 1976 - a total of fifty-eight.

Frankford was not always a Station or a Circuit. It was organized as an "official circuit" in 1858 – with either six or eight churches. Records are not clear, but at that time it consisted of Frankford, Selbyville, Bishopville, Roxana, Millsboro, and Dagsboro.

In 1870, Roxana Circuit was formed leaving Frankford Circuit with only four preaching places. In 1873, one of the preaching places was dropped and Houston School House was added. In 1876, a Church was built to be used instead of the Houston School House.

Selbyville left the Circuit in 1886 and became a station. It was not until 1951 that Frankford became a Station, and remained such until 1961, when Millville was added to the Charge and remained until 1966. It was then dropped and Hickory Hill and Ebenezer were added. In 1974, Ebenezer fazed out leaving Hickory Hill and Frankford together serving under the pastorate of Reverend Curtis W. Smith.

HISTORY OF THE FRANKFORD METHODIST CHURCH

Prior to 1853 the Methodists worshiped in a church located between Frankford and Dagsboro in a woods about one-quarter mile northeast of the John M. Clayton School [now Indian River High School]. On April 10, 1819, the Frankford Methodist Church, known as "Antioch", purchased this site from Joshua Robinson at a cost of \$14.371/2. Here they worshiped until 1853. No record has been found of the minister serving the Frankford church from 1819 to 1852.

Antioch M. E. Church, Frankford, Delaware was built in the 1853 A.D., on a lot purchased from Jonathan & Elizabeth Carey, the deed being dated, November 20, 1952. The new church as dedicated to the worship of Almighty God on Sunday, August 28, 1853.

Frankford was a part of the Berlin circuit which was formerly on the Snow Hill circuit organized in 1809. In the spring of 1858, the Frankford circuit was formed out of territory belonging to the Berlin circuit, under Reverend Henry Colclazer*, presiding elder of the Snow Hill District, Maryland.

Frankford remained a part of a circuit ranging from six to eight churches to two, until 1951 when it became a station. The Hotel property at the rear of the church was purchased in October, 1958, from Mr. & Mrs. Donald Simpler at a cost of \$5,000.

The records show that W. Prink was the minister in 1852.

FRANKFORD UNITED METHODIST CHURCH HOMECOMING – 1990

Antioch M. E. Church, Frankford, Delaware was built in the year A.D. 1853 and dedicated to the worship of Almighty God on Sunday, August 28, 1853. Prior to 1853, the Methodist worshiped between Frankford and Dagsboro beyond the colored church on farms now owned by Ernest Long. Frankford Circuit was formed in the Spring of 1858 out of territory belonging to Berlin Circuit and was composed of the following appointments: Namely – Millsborough, Phillips Hill, Antioch or Frankford, Salem, Sound, Bishopville, St. George's and Cedar Neck; Reverend Henry Coldazler*, Presiding Elder of Snow Hill District, and Robert Hazzard and William T. Tulls on Frankford Circuit.

The church at Frankford was throughly repaired and remodeled in 1875 at a cost of \$1,200.

In 1873, Houston's School House was taken up as a preaching place, and a class formed, but there is little hope of ever accomplishing much unless they build a house of worship. School house appointments do well for a year or two and then go down.

The church in Frankford for two years was very much hindered by crop failures and depression of business and, despite all possible struggle and effort, there was some falling off in the benevolent collections. Not withstanding the hard times, the Church received some necessary repairs including a new roof (which was elevated at the peak six feet higher than the old, painting of the exterior of the Church, refitting of seats to all costing near five hundred dollars. During the two years, the parsonage debt was reduced from the neighborhood of \$550 to \$282 as it stood on January 7, 1891, and during 1890, an accumulation of old debts on the church amounting to \$256 was paid in full. Among these old debts was a sexton's unpaid salary bill for some \$80 which had been standing some three or four years.

In the fall of 1889, a revival of considerable interest took place at Houston's resulting in some 27 conversions. At a camp meeting at Lamb's Woods in 180, 27 conversions took place. In the fall and winter of 1890, a

great revival took place at St. George's. Sixty-three professed conversions. Nearly all were adults. Congregations were sometimes larger than the Church would contain. Nearly all of these joined the Church. Considerable spiritual interest prevailed in Frankford early in 1891 in the Church, but eight only, professed conversions.

Charles F. Sheppart was appointed to the charge in 1889. He found a considerable number of probationers at Frankford very many of whom lapsed or moved away. A. D. Davis was appointed to succeed Reverend W. F. Duhadway. March 19, 1885, number of conversions during the conference year about 140. Received on probation 127. Net increase in full members, 75. Paid about \$200 on parsonage debt. Left at end of first year to do evangelical work.

The old St. George's Church was first built about 1815. Methodism seems to have reached this section. Whitesville Church organized 1778-80. Old Salem, Selbyville, 1810.

Additions, 1858. A plank church was built at Mudford about this time but has since passed away. Mariner's Bethel also appeared about this time.

The first year Houston's was finished and dedicated was 1878. In the spring of 1869, Roxana circuit was formed. W. F. Duhadway was appointed in 1882 and remained three years. The various records will indicate the amount of strictly spiritual work accomplished during this term. Besides that a parsonage has been built at Frankford and a new church at Selbyville.

The parsonage at 12 Clayton Avenue was completely remodeled in the summer and fall of 1990. We hope it will serve as an inspiration to what can be accomplished when the Spirit is strong.

During the two years the parsonage dert was reduced from the neighborhood of 550 to 282 as it stood on Jan 7, 1891 and during 1890 an accumulation of old debts on the hourch amounting to 256 was paid in full.

Among these old debts was sexton's unpaid salary bill for wome 80. which had been standing some three or four years.
