DECLARATION OF COMMISSION

Kent County on Delaware.

We the subscribers, being the Militia Light Infantry Company of Dover, do hereby associate and bind ourselves by every tie of Honor, Virtue and Goodfaith, to adhere, and stand firm together, at the risk of our lives and fortunes, in the Defense and Protection of American Liberty: And we do further hereby submit ourselves, when on duty, to the due and proper orders and commands of our officers according to the customs of Military Discipline, and to the Laws, Articles and Rules, already enacted, made or ordered, or here after to be enacted, made or ordered by the House of Assembly of this Government, for the better Regulation of the Militia within the same: And also when called into actual service, to the Laws, Articles and Rules made or to be made by the Continental State Congress for the Government of the Continental Army.

To whom it may concern, be it known that I certify, on Honor, that has been officially commissioned, on this occasion of our 300th Anniversary of American Independence, to the temporary rank of in the Light Infantry Company of Dover, First Battalion of Kent County on Delaware this day A.D. 197
