• Reverend Lewis Wheeler Wells Collection, Journals

The journals contain daily entries noting the date, weather, and various topics such as local churches, politics, travel, shipbuilding, trains, schools, and notable events like a circus, an execution, and a fire. They include records of church services, baptisms, and community life, with details on attendance, offerings, and individuals involved. The 1896–1900 volume originally recorded services in 1882, and the 1903–1904 volume includes baptism records from St. Mary the Virgin in New York City (1876–1881).

This 16mm film features the segment "Activities in European Theatre of Operations." Capsized and sunken battleships. Submarines being inspected. Holocaust survivors being fed, treated, and moved out of the camps. Camps being burned down. The Disney Swish. Rocket propelled bombs being tested. Enemy Fortifications. Shows hidden enemy fortifications. Mine Menace in Conquered Areas. Civilians being taught how mines work, how to find and disable them. T-66 Rocket Launcher. Showing how it works. Jungle Rescue. Troops being rescued and cared for. Activities in the Philippines. McArthur. Troops packing up. Planes being repaired or scavenged. Attack on Naha. Combat Footage. Donated by Dover Air Force Base.

This 16mm film includes the segment "Secretary Stimson and General Marshall Make V-E Day Statement" and "Activities on Okinawa." Japanese Civilians leaving underground fortifications. Combat footage. Aerial and naval combat. Mop-Up in Manila Harbor. Shows Japanese troops being captured and given water. Activities in European Theatre of Operations. Shows U.S. troops checking citizens and looking for spies. Shows stash of artifacts the Germans stole. Flag raising ceremony. Additional atrocity Films. Shows Jews who survived and didn't survive the increased execution rates as U.S. forces closed in. Eisenhower. German citizens are forced to see what were done in the camps. Surrender. Shows German forces surrendering. General Eisenhower Speaks on V-E Day. Donated by Dover Air Force Base.
